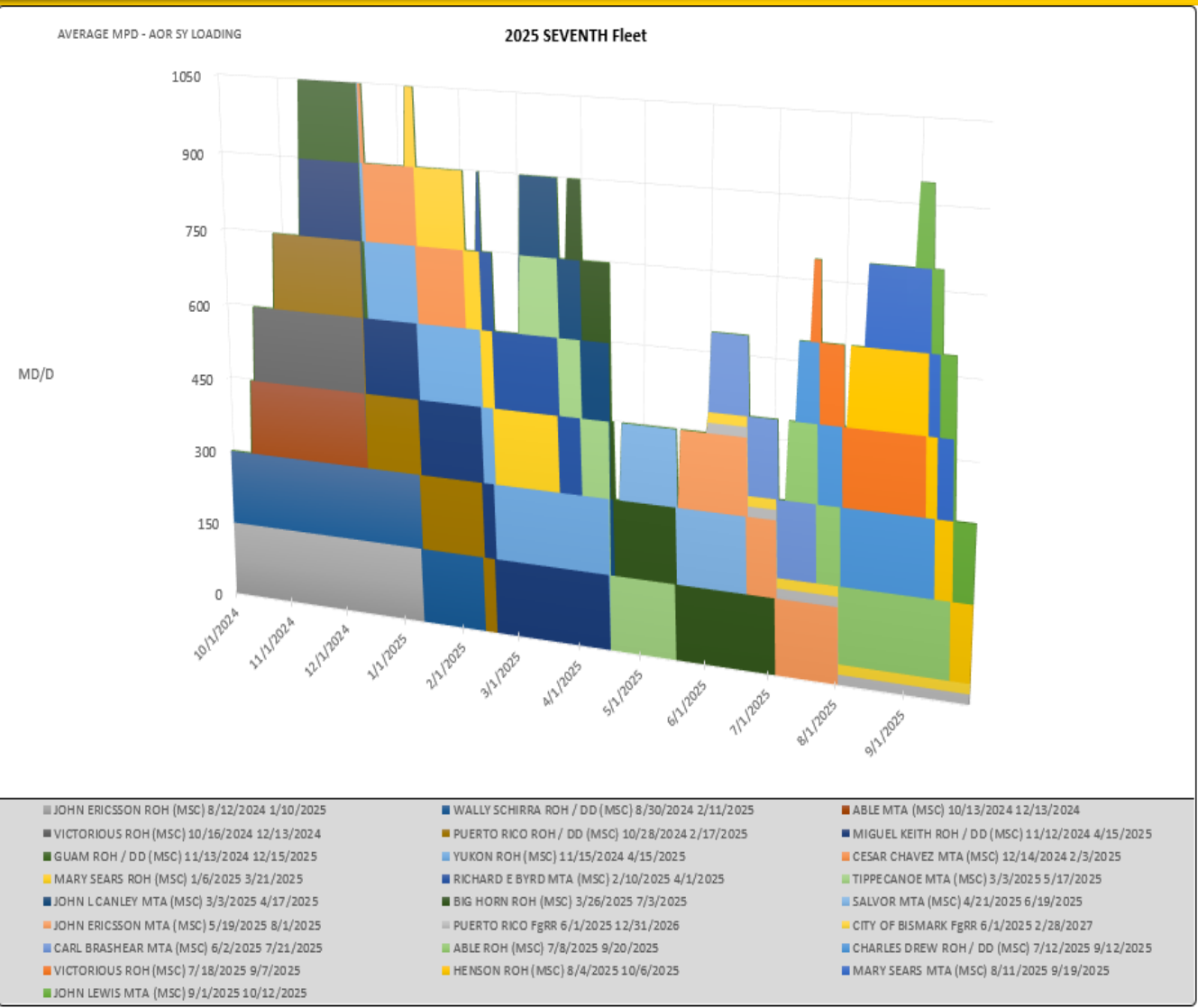


FY24-26 7th Fleet Shipyard Loading





FY25 7th Fleet Shipyard Loading

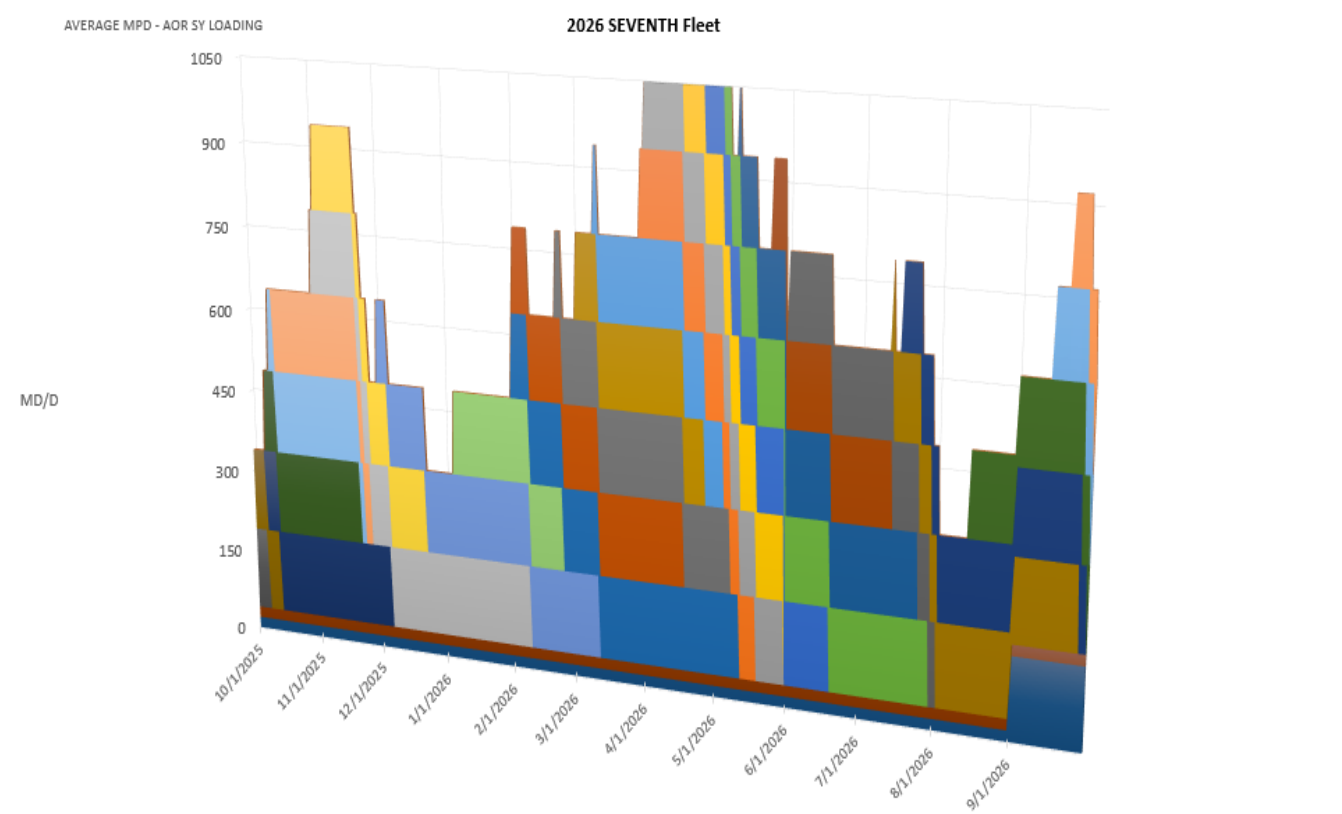

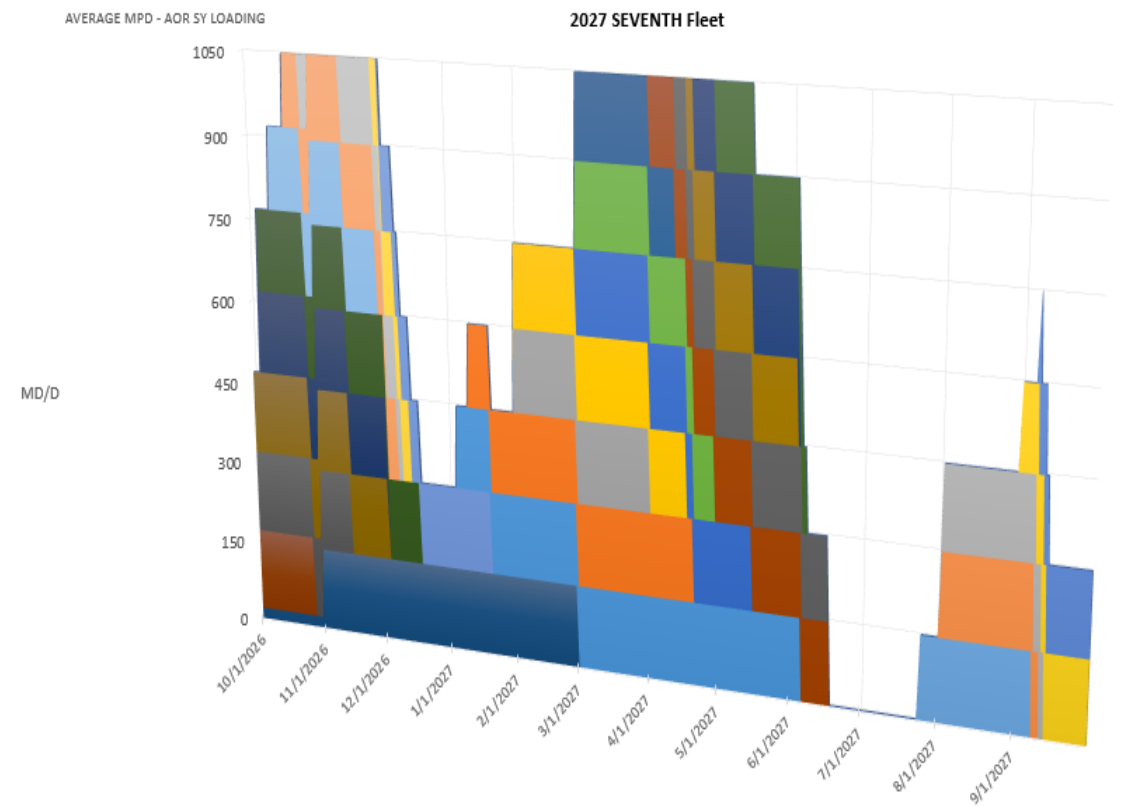

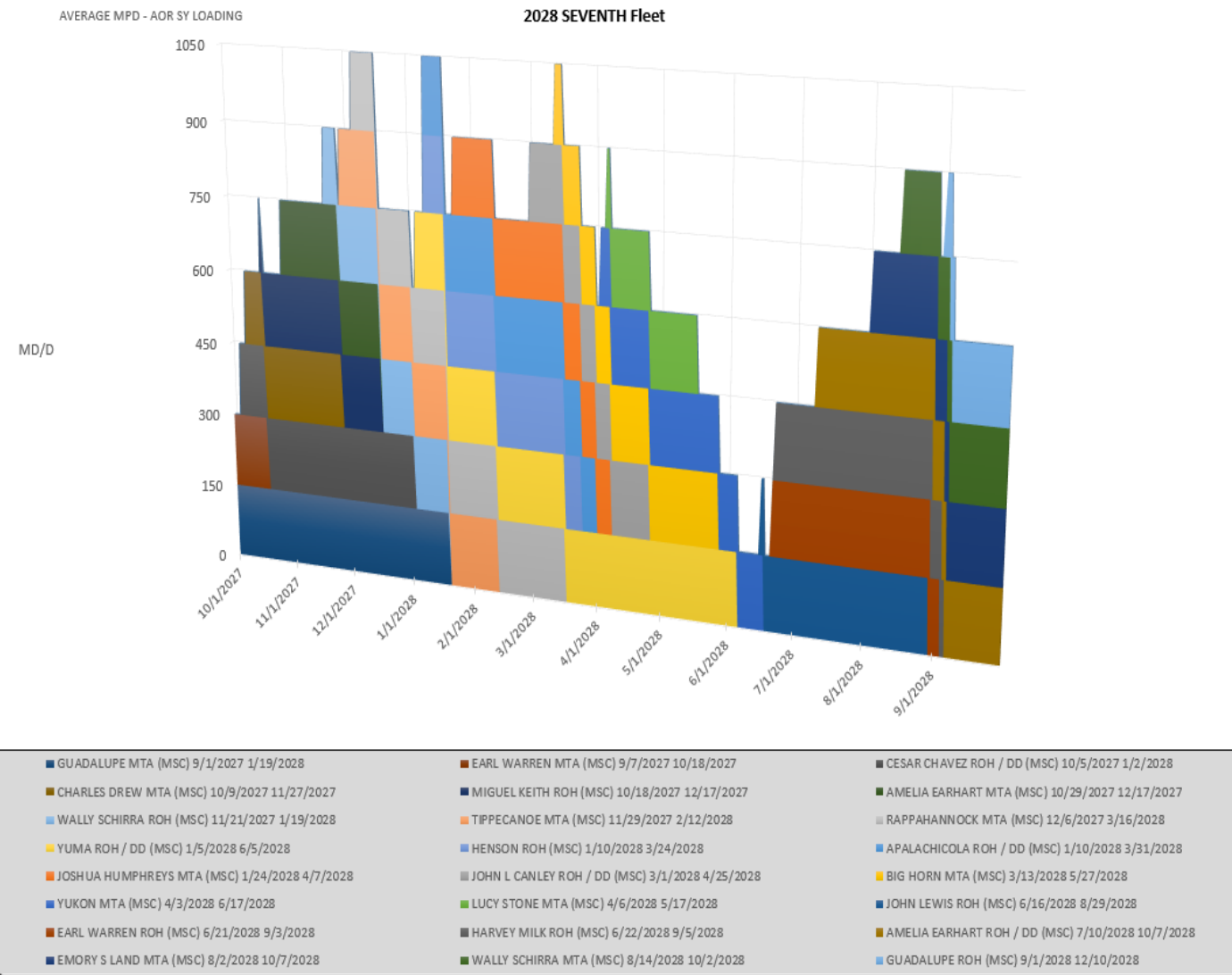
